In medieval times the town became important for the presence of a defensive structure (the Rocca of Civitillo) of which unfortunately just a few traces have survived. The ancient Abbey of San Clemente al Vomano, recently restored and opened to the public is a major attraction within the municipality, as well as the archaeological site of Grasciano, discovered in 1992, whose excavations allowed to bring to light a number of remains likely attributable to a rural settlement dating back to the Roman period, the most significant of which are exhibited in the civic Museum of the town.



Notaresco is a medieval town in the province of Teramo - Abruzzo Region – Italy, counting around 7.000 inhabitants. It is located at an altitude of 267 meters above sea level and covers an hilly area of around 38.14 sq km within the Valley of the Abbeys, a tourist route witness of an ancient time with its beautiful abbeys where visitors will find a friendly welcome, experience many natural, cultural and artistic attractions, enjoy good food, wine and all the products of this generous land (<http://www.valledelleabbazie.it/>).





Abruzzo Irish Festival

The event, created in 2014 to promote Irish culture by virtue of its numerous similarities with the traditions of Abruzzo Region, and hosted in Notaresco on a yearly basis, has immediately met a great success in terms of audience (16.000 visitors during its first edition). Realized with the contribution of different local associations, it focuses on the revival of traditional cultures (music, poetry and games), typical productions and food.
