Brief Description	<p>The Paphos Chamber of Commerce and Industry (PCCI) is a non-profit organization, federated with the Cyprus Chamber of Commerce and Industry. It has been set up to develop and promote the trade, the industry, the services and general every business activity to the whole district of Paphos. It was established in its present Legal form in 1963. The Chamber of Paphos has conducted more than 200 seminars, lectures, workshops and conferences over the last 20 years, in collaboration with the Human Resource Development Authority of Cyprus. Through our training programs, we have trained over 4000 professionals. Over time the Chamber's Administration recognizes the needs of the Paphian business world and offers training programs intended to meet these needs.</p> <p>The Province of Paphos covers 1395 square kilometres and it represents roughly the 15% of the total extent of Cyprus. With a population around 90.000 residents, it also represents the 10% of the total population of the island. The growth of the City and Province of Paphos began after 1974 and was continued with a lower pace after the 80's. The Paphos Chamber of Commerce and Industry was honoured to have prominent business figures of Cyprus in its Board of Directors and the Administrative councils. Their experience, the prestige and their hard work contributed in the economic growth of Paphos and Cyprus in general.</p> <p>Today the Chamber numbers more than 500 members and includes in its provinces 6 professional Associations.
